

## CREATING A BOOKMARK / SHORTCUT

The websites used for continuing medical education are designed to be user-friendly for mobile devices. For sites frequently visited, creating a bookmark / shortcut that creates an icon/widget on your mobile device saves time.

Suggested URLs to create bookmarks for:

**NortonCME.com** – To quickly access a listing of all CME activities, access to online activities, conference registration, transcripts, sign in to your account and more. Additionally, the ‘conference/details’ link will provide presentations and information for symposiums/conferences.

**NortonRSS.com** – To claim attendance for regularly scheduled series (RSS) such as Tumor Boards and Grand Rounds with the codes provided at the event.

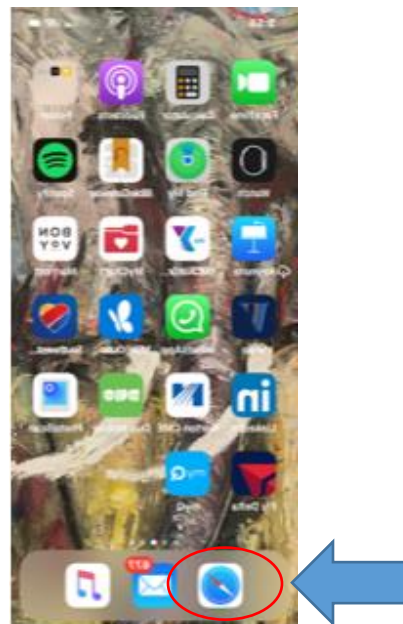
**NortonGrandRounds.com** - To livestream Pediatric Grand Rounds and Pediatric Resident Grand Rounds.

*Note: As of May 1, the Norton Healthcare CME app will no longer be available.*

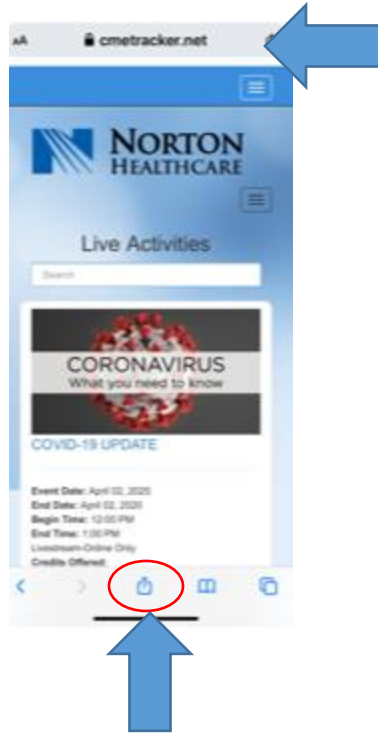
The following highlights steps to create a shortcut / bookmark on Apple and Android devices.

### DIRECTIONS FOR APPLE DEVICES (iPHONE / IPAD)

#### 1. Select web browser

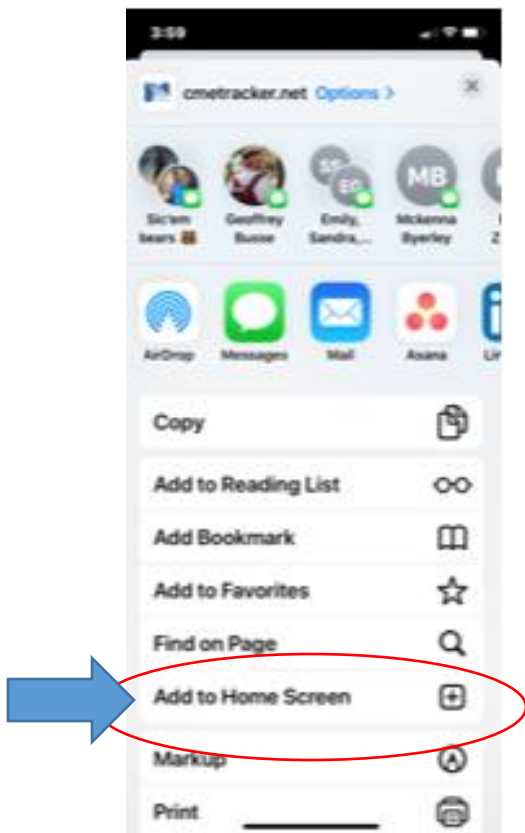


- 2. Enter web address
- 3. Select 'share'

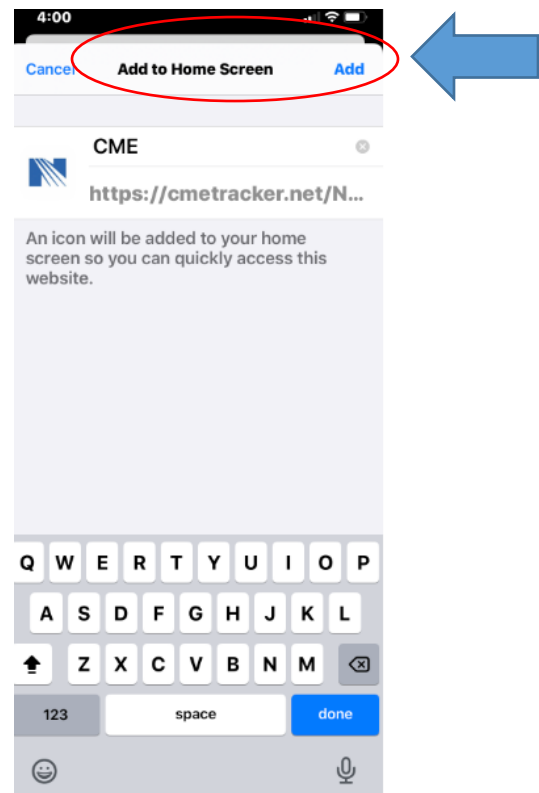


- 4. Select 'Add to Home Screen'

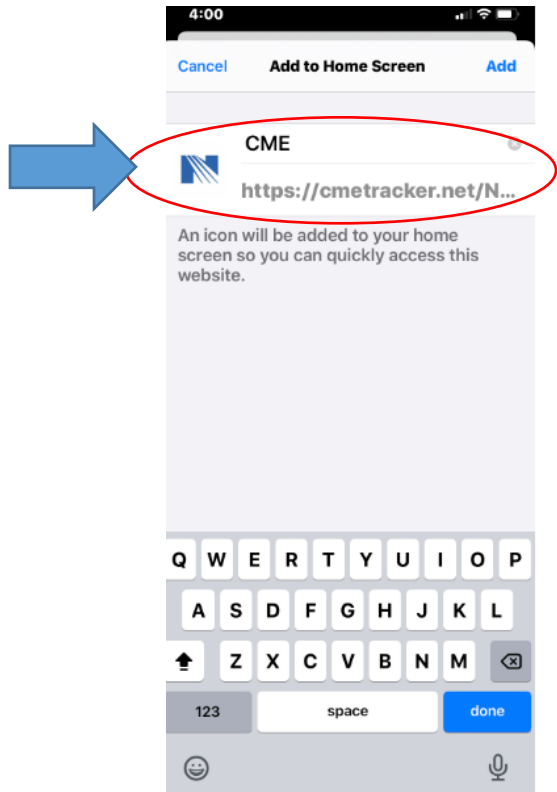
First screen



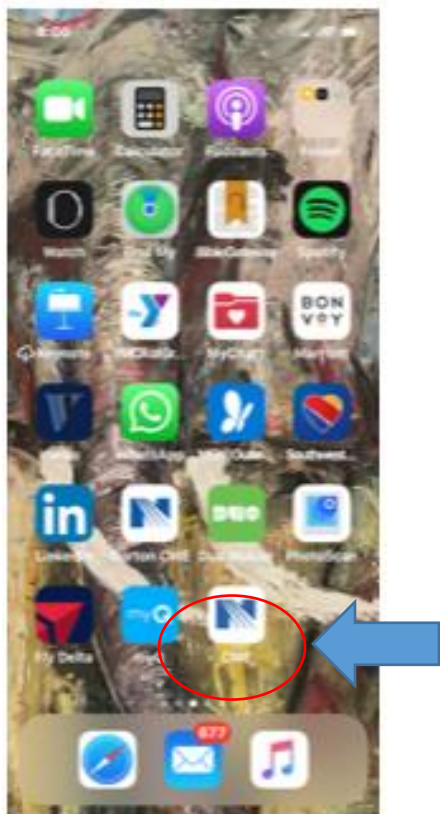
Second screen, confirm 'Add'



5. Name shortcut / bookmark (This name will appear under the image.)

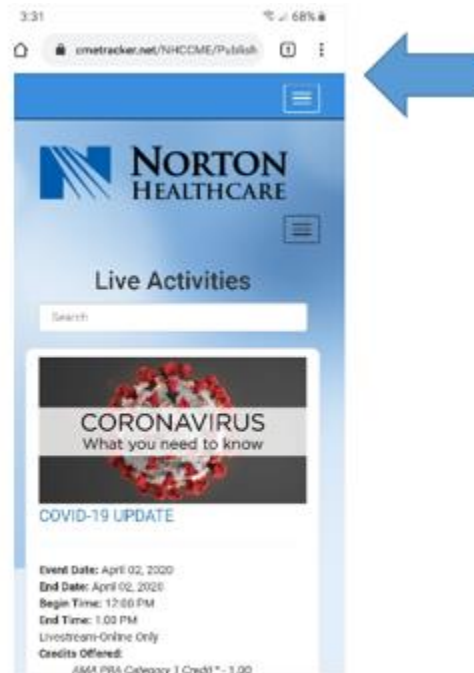


6. Finished! The shortcut/bookmark has been added to your iPhone/iPad.

1. Select preferred web browser
2. Enter web address



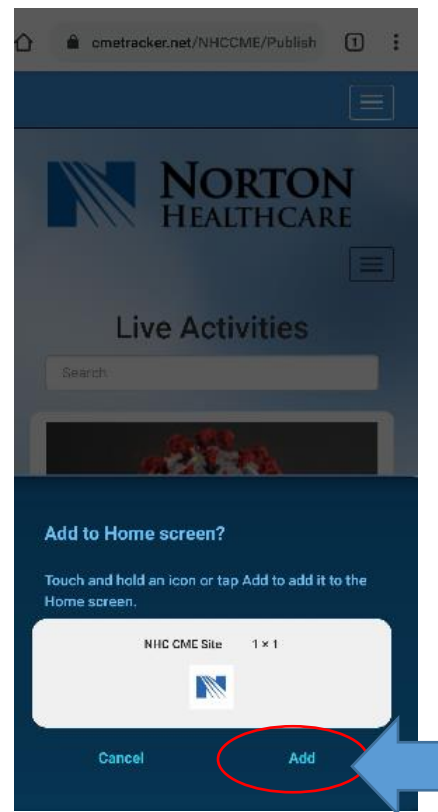
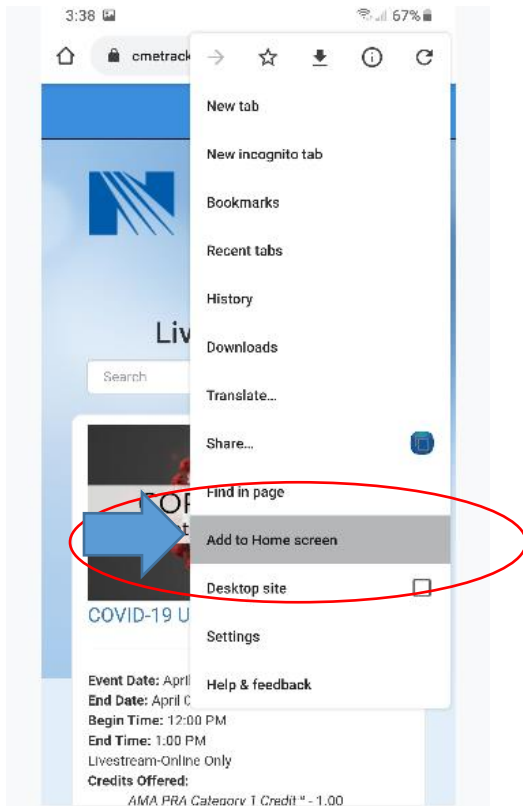
3. Select icon at the top to add the URL to the home screen.

First screen

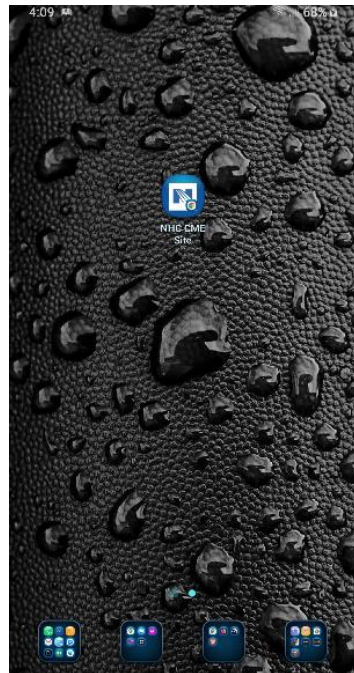
Second screen, confirm 'Add'
