## POLICY

Any research conducted in a Norton Healthcare facility will have approval from the University of Louisville Human Subjects Protection Program Institutional Review Board, the Western Institutional Review Board (WIRB), or for student research an institution with which Norton Healthcare has an IRB Authorization Agreement (IAA). The investigator will follow the rules and regulations set forth by the respective IRB (i.e., annual review, amendments, informed consent) or he/she cannot conduct research in a Norton Healthcare facility. Those researchers affiliated with the University of Louisville or utilizing a University of Louisville facility for research must use the U of L IRB as the IRB of record. Those not affiliated with the University of Louisville may use the U of L IRB, WIRB, or the IRB identified in an IAA as the IRB of record.

For all research intended to be conducted at a NHC facility in which the University of Louisville Institutional Review Board is the IRB of record, an electronic application must be submitted to U of L IRB through the BRAAN2 (electronic) system. Instructions for using BRAAN2 may be found on the IRB's website, http://louisville.edu/research/humansubjects. If a NHC facility is selected as a research site on the application, the NHORA will have access to all documents in the system associated with the research study. Please direct all BRAAN2 questions to the HSPPO at 502-852-5188.

For all research intended to be conducted in a NHC facility in which the Western IRB (WIRB) is the IRB of record, the application must be submitted to NHORA for conditional approval prior to submission to WIRB. The WIRB submission materials are available on their website, www.wirb.com. WIRB will not accept a NHC application without the NHORA conditional approval letter.
